

ELIGIBILITY

Lincoln County Senior Games and SilverArts are open to all Lincoln County Residents age 50 and better. Participants must reside in North Carolina at least 3 consecutive months out of the year. Participants must be able to show proof of NC residency. Photo ID will be required at check-in for all events. Non-residents of Lincoln County may participate upon approval from the Local Coordinator. Your age on December 31, 2019 will determine the category that you will compete in. Men and Women compete in separate categories in the following age groups: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+. In doubles competition and in team sports, the age category is determined by the age of the youngest player. Competition in SilverArts is based on sub-category, not age.

REGISTRATION

To register for the Lincoln County Senior Games and/or the SilverArts, complete the entry form and submit payment to Lincoln County Parks and Recreation, no later than **Friday, March 1st**. Each individual, including both doubles partners and all team members, must submit a completed entry form with total payment to **Lincoln County Parks and Recreation by March 1st**. Performing Arts and Cheerleaders should complete one SilverArts entry form per act or group. *The deadline is strictly enforced in fairness to all participants*.

FEES

To participate in the Lincoln County Senior Games and/or the SilverArts, there is a \$10.00 Early Bird Entry Fee and \$12.00 Fee (after 2/15/19). A facility fee will be charged for those who wish to participate in the following activities: Bowling (\$6.00 per event), Cycling (\$10.00 per event), Golf (\$22.00 for 18 holes), and the Closing Ceremony/Banquet (\$5.00). There is also a \$5 GUEST fee for the closing ceremony/banquet. These facility fees are in addition to the entry fee. Your entry fee includes the following: a LCSG T-Shirt and admission to the Opening Ceremony, Performing Arts Follies and the SilverArts Showcase.

RULES

All events will be conducted in accordance with the 2019 edition of the North Carolina Senior Games, Inc. Official Rule Book. A copy of the official rules will be available at the Games. The official rule book is also available online at www.ncseniorgames.org. Complete rules for SilverArts are listed below.

EVENT REPORTING TIMES

All participants should report to their events at least 15 minutes early to pick up registration information. For outdoor events, it is recommended to bring a chair.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SIGN IN AND SHOW A PHOTO ID AT EACH EVENT.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Phone calls regarding starting times will not be made to each individual. All brackets will be available at the check-in time of each event. Participants who do not check in by the scheduled starting time will forfeit that event. Participants are also responsible for remaining at tournament events until they have completed their competition.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In case of inclement weather, call Lincoln County Parks and Recreation at 704-748-1518 or check the Lincoln County Senior Games facebook page for updates. Unless conditions are hazardous to the safety of volunteers and participants, events will continue. Event Managers will have the latest information. In the event of inclement weather, Opening Ceremonies will be moved to March 30th.

AWARDS

Each participant who finishes first, second, or third in each age group, male and female, will receive gold, silver, or bronze medals. Medals will be presented at the event.

*** Medals not picked up at the events will be available at closing ceremonies.***

OUALIFYING FOR STATE FINALS

To qualify, a participant must place 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any official sports event offered at the Lincoln County Senior Games. **EXCEPTION: Golfers must meet the Minimum Performance Scores (MPS)** & finish in the top 3 in their age group to qualify for State Finals.

HERITAGE ARTS

Sub-Categories: Basket Weaving, ** Ceramics, **China Painting, Crocheting, ** Doll Making, Jewelry, Knitting, **Miscellaneous, Needlework, Pottery (hand built or thrown), Quilting (hand stitched), Quilting (machine stitched), **Rugs (hooked, braided, woven), Stained Glass, **Tatting & Needlelace, Tole & Decorative Painting, Weaving, Woodcarving, Woodturning, and Woodworking.

- * Heritage Art must be an original work.
- * Entries must be the work of the individual and not a group.
- * Patterns may be used, but no stamped pieces will be accepted.
- * Pottery must be hand built or thrown.
- * Latch hook rugs and pieces from ceramic molds will not be accepted.
- * All framed work must be securely wired, ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Two-dimensional work not properly framed and wired will not be displayed.
- * Framed works can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- * Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- * All entries, except framed work, must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3'(L) x 5'(H).
- * Groupings (sets) shall have no more than 3 separate pieces per set. All objects within each piece of the set must be contained within or attached to one of the 3 pieces of the set.
- * Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- * Artist must send a photo of entry with *State Finals Entry Form* and *Silver Arts Information Form*. Photos cannot be returned.
- * Artists, or their representatives, are responsible to deliver and pick-up their entry at/during the designated times
- * The Heritage Arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- * An artist may only submit one entry per sub-category in LCSG and at State Finals

VISUAL ARTS

Sub-categories: Acrylics, Drawing, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastels, Photography, Sculpture, Watercolor

- * All artwork, except sculpture, must be framed, securely wired, and ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Artwork, except sculpture, not properly wired will not be displayed.
- * Artwork, except sculpture, can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- * Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- * Sculpture groupings (sets) may have no more than 3 pieces per grouping (set).
- * Mixed media may be a freestanding piece.
- * Freestanding entries must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3'(L) x 5'(H)
- * Artists, or their representatives, are responsible to deliver and pick-up their entry at/during the designated times.
- * If on-site assembly is required, details must be specified on the Information Form for NCSG prior approval.
- * The art piece must be an original work, not a print.
- * Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- * Artist must send a photograph of entry with *State Finals Entry Form* and *Silver Arts Information Form*. Photos cannot be returned.
- * The visual arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- * An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category in LCSG and at State Finals.
- * The original and all copies will be retained by NCSG, Inc.
- * The Visual Arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.

LITERARY ARTS

Sub-category: Essay, Life Experience, Poem, Short Story-Fiction

- * All entries must be typed, double-spaced, on $8-1/2 \times 11$ paper and have a minimum of 1" margins. A minimum font size is 10-point type.
- * Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
- * Short stories, essays, and life experiences can be no longer than 8 pages.
- * All entries must have a title page, which includes title of work, sub-category, and name of artist. Artist's name should not appear on the content pages.
- * The literary arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- * An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category in LCSG and at State Finals.
- * A **display-quality copy** of the winning Literary Arts entries, and three (3) additional photocopies, should be submitted to NCSG by the artist with their official State Finals Entry Form and Silver Arts Information Form.

Sub-Categories- Comedy/Drama, Dance, Instrumental, Line dance, Vocal.

YOU MAY ONLY ENTER 3 ACTS TOTAL (1 per sub-category)

- * Performing entries are limited to 3 minutes of on-stage time. Exceeding the time limit will result in automatic disqualification. Timing begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the exit of the last performer from the stage or final movement of the act. Cheerleader acts will be allowed a maximum of 4 minutes of performance time.
- * Performing entries may be one of the following: (a) soloists, (b) small groups (2 4 performers), or (c) large groups (5 -20 performers). Accompanist(s) will be counted to determine size of act. No one under age 50 as of December 31st will be permitted on stage and an accompanist *must* be a registered participant.
- * LCSG can only provide a sound system with microphones and chairs. Please specify what you need. You are responsible for all other equipment and props (including music stands, tables, etc.). Provide very specific details on size, weight, etc. Props must be small, few, lightweight, and easy to set up quickly.
- * If your act requires additional props/technical equipment, you must attach a list of all other props & technical equipment you plan to bring.
- * All performers for all acts must enter stage right and exit stage left or begin and end on the stage. See the Silver Arts Manual for a stage diagram.
- * If recorded music is used, the artist/group leader must provide to LCSG by March 11th (**with** Entry Forms) a high-quality CD for their performance. No recorded instruction is permitted. Artists should pick up their music after the performance it will not be mailed/returned. Their music/song should be the only music on the CD.
- * Voice presentations must be a *live* performance by the artist. Background music can be recorded. Lip-synch is not permitted as a performing art.
- * No live animals are allowed, except for service animals.
- * The Group Leader, who must be a participant, must complete the *Silver Arts Information Form* for the group and submit it with their *Entry Form*, and each member of the group must submit their own personal *Entry Form* by the March 1st deadline.
- * At State Finals, NCSG can provide the following items: Microphone(s), Piano, Sound system, and CD player. The act is responsible for all other props and equipment (including music stands, chairs, etc.) and must get NCSG advance approval for use at Show.

Follies Mandatory Rehearsal will be held Friday, March 8 at 5 pm at the Lincoln County Cultural Center.

AWARDS

Follies and Cheerleading participants will receive their medals the evening of the Follies Showcase.

QUALIFYING FOR STATE FINALS

In SilverArts, ONLY the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place finishers in Heritage & Visual Arts, the 1st & 2nd place finishers in Literary Arts, the 1st place finisher in Cheerleading and the "Best of Show" winner in Performing Arts will qualify for State Finals competition. If for any reason the act that wins "Best of Show" can't participate at State Finals, the act that finishes as the first runner-up will have the opportunity to advance to State Finals. **The**

performance at State Finals must be the same performance that won at the Local Games; i.e. same song, dance, music, etc.
