### \*\*\*COVID GUIDELINES & SAFETY PRECAUTIONS\*\*\*

The health and safety of our participants and staff are our top priority each year with Lincoln County Senior Games. Lincoln County Senior Games will be following the COVID19 safety guidelines and recommendations provided by the Lincoln County Health Department, NC DHHS, and the CDC for all events. If you have been sick, feel sick on the day of event, are currently positive for COVID19 or have been a close contact with someone, please stay home! If you miss an event, we will work with you to make up the event or provide a refund of registration costs if you can't participate.

## ELIGIBILITY

Lincoln County Senior Games and SilverArts are open to all Lincoln County Residents age 50 and better. Participants must reside in North Carolina at least 3 consecutive months out of the year. Participants must be able to show proof of NC residency. Photo ID will be required at check-in for all events. Non-residents of Lincoln County may participate upon approval from the Local Coordinator. Your age on December 31, 2021 will determine the category that you will compete in. Men and Women compete in separate categories in the following age groups: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+. In doubles competition and in team sports, the age category is determined by the age of the youngest player. Competition in SilverArts is based on sub-category, not age.

## REGISTRATION

To register for the Lincoln County Senior Games and/or the SilverArts, complete the entry form and submit payment to Lincoln County Parks and Recreation, no later than **Friday, March 12th**. Each individual, including both doubles partners and all team members, must submit a completed entry form with total payment to **Lincoln County Parks and Recreation by March 12th**. Performing Arts and Cheerleaders should complete one SilverArts entry form per act or group. *The deadline is strictly enforced in fairness to all participants.*

## FEES

To participate in the Lincoln County Senior Games and/or the SilverArts there is a **\$10.00 fee**. A facility fee will be charged for those who wish to participate in the following activities: **Cycling (\$10.00 per event), Golf (\$22.00 for 18 holes), and the Closing Ceremony (\$5.00)**. **There is also a \$5 GUEST fee for the Closing Ceremony**. These facility fees are in addition to the entry fee.



# ATHLETIC EVENT INFORMATION

## RULES

All events will be conducted in accordance with the 2021 edition of the North Carolina Senior Games, Inc. Official Rule Book. A copy of the official rules will be available at the Games. The official rule book is also available online at [www.ncseniorgames.org](http://www.ncseniorgames.org). Complete rules for SilverArts are also available.

## EVENT INFORMATION

Our 2021 Senior Games and SilverArts will consist of both in-person and virtual events. We will not have our normal large group gatherings or events. This year those events will be virtual for everyone to join from home.

For our virtual events, participants will submit their scores/times to the Lincoln County Senior Games coordinator by the deadline posted in this packet. Virtual events are to be completed on your own at home or in the community. If you need assistance with any of the virtual events, please contact the Senior Games staff.

Our in-person events will be different than in year's past. **Participants and staff will be required to wear masks and social distance at each event.** Each event will also have limited capacity in the event area. Some of these events will be adapted as they were for the NC Senior Games Virtual State Finals. If you have questions about a specific event please contact the Senior Games staff.

### What to expect at Lincoln County Senior Games Events:

- \* Masks are required for all participants and staff
- \* Participants will sign-in at each event with a staff member in the designated area.
- \* At sign-in, participants will be asked a series of screening questions before entering participation area.
- \* All participants and staff will adhere to social distancing of at least 6 ft. during the event.
- \* Participants are encouraged to bring their own equipment when possible.
- \* Any shared equipment will be sanitized with use by staff.

## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Phone calls regarding starting times will not be made to each individual. All brackets will be available at the check-in time of each event. Participants who do not check in by the scheduled starting time will forfeit that event. Participants are also responsible for remaining at tournament events until they have completed their competition.

## AWARDS

Each participant who finishes first, second, or third in each age group, male and female, will receive gold, silver, or bronze medals. Some of our award ceremonies will be in-person after events as they have been in the past. Some award ceremonies will be held virtually at the end of the week after events are completed. Medals will be available at the Parks and Recreation office for participants after the virtual ceremonies or at the Closing Ceremony Drive-Thru event.

## QUALIFYING FOR STATE FINALS

To qualify, a participant must place 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any official sports event offered at the Lincoln County Senior Games.

We are excited that the SilverArts portion of Lincoln County Senior Games will occur without much change. **SilverArts participants will drop off their entries curbside at the Lincoln Cultural Center on Tuesday, March 16th from 10 a.m. until 1 p.m. Staff will meet you at the curbside area to take your entries.** SilverArts participants will not be entering the Cultural Center during this drop-off. The SilverArts Gallery will then open to the public on Friday, March 19th. There is a safety capacity for the public in the gallery space. Please follow these directions by the Cultural Center staff. Ribbons for our SilverArts winners will be in place when the gallery opens on Friday, March 19th. The SilverArts Award Ceremony will be a virtual ceremony and be hosted on our Lincoln County Senior Games Facebook page and via Zoom for participants. The virtual ceremony will take place on Friday, March 19th at 6:00 p.m.

The SilverArts Gallery will be open until the end of March for visits. SilverArts pick-up will operate as a curbside event as well. All SilverArts entries must be picked up on Wednesday, March 31st between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. Please let our Senior Games staff know if you need to make other accommodations to pick up your entries. We will present medals to entry winners during the curbside pick-up.

The Performing Arts portion of the SilverArts will take place at the Cultural Center on Saturday, March 27th at 5 p.m. The Cultural Center has a capacity limit for social distancing in the performance hall so we will have limited public access for this event. We will live stream the performing arts event for families to watch from home on our LCSG Facebook page. We will have rehearsals on Friday, March 26th at 5:00 p.m. For the performing arts event, the Cultural Center staff are well-versed in operating events with social distancing and safety guidelines in place. **For performing arts event, masks will be required for all in attendance and for participants when not on stage performing.**

## QUALIFYING FOR STATE FINALS

In SilverArts, ONLY the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place finishers in Heritage & Visual Arts, the 1st & 2nd place finishers in Literary Arts, the 1st place finisher in Cheerleading and the "Best of Show" winner in Performing Arts will qualify for State Finals competition. If for any reason the act that wins "Best of Show" can't participate at State Finals, the act that finishes as the first runner-up will have the opportunity to advance to State Finals. **The performance at State Finals must be the same performance that won at the Local Games; i.e. same song, dance, music, etc.**
